(make sure to check the information under the Guinea pigs tab as you fill out this form to make informed choices)!

- 1. Determine where you will obtain your Guinea pig from; a reputable breeder, reputable pet store, rescuing or adopting one. (Remember that a reputable breeder is highly recommended). How will you bring your Guinea pig home? You will need a travel cage. We have recommended some good ones and what to put in the travel cage.
- 2. After figuring out where you will get your Guinea pig, you will obviously have found out the price and when you will be expecting your Guinea pig. With this information, you can prepare for your Guinea pig's arrival by making sure you have obtained what your Guinea pig will need:

3. Another very important thing to do is make a savings plan for your Guinea pig. The things that will need frequent purchasing are substrate bedding, litter and food. If you go with fleece, the only thing you will be doing is frequent cleaning. Buying fleece is only done if you notice it is worn out, which occurs after a very long time. However, initially you will have to purchase a number to be changing out after cleans. Also, save for vet bills. You will get good at this as you have hands on experience with your Guinea pig. (For savvy vets, you can always ask the breeder for a contact).
